<u>VOTE -</u> The meeting was called to order at 6:50pm with a quorum present. The financial statements of Cultural Arts Academy Charter School provided by Stuart Sabal were presented by Hank Clouden. These statements were discussed in detailed. After discussion, a motion was made by Chrysetta Patterson to accept two changes as presented by the Treasurer. The motion was seconded by Shirley Glasgow. The vote was unanimous.

Other Discussion:

The International Baccalaureate Primary Years Program Authorization Update – IB has responded to our August 1st response. We previously had 11 revisions to address. We now have 6 revisions to address. Of those 6 issues, we now have strong evidence to support that we are addressing these tasks. We now have a more clear understanding of what they are looking for and the documentation that is needed to complete authorization. We have the opportunity to submit documentation to address these 6 issues by the deadline of December 31st. It takes

IB about 4-6 months to get back to us after a submission. We made significant progress and we are confident this next submission will be our last one required. We can expect to be authorized before the end of this school year. A motion was made by Cheryl Pemberton to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Chrysetta Patterson.
