According to Charter School Law, Cultural Arts Academy Charter School at Spring Creek “shall enroll each eligible student who submits a timely application by the first day of April each year, unless the number of applications exceeds the capacity of the grade level or building.” In such cases, students shall be accepted from among applicants by a random selection (lottery) process. Seats are automatically given to currently enrolled students. CAACS will make sure that outreach to children with special needs and English Language Learners is maximized.
